ELIGIBILITY

- ACT Score of 18 or higher within the last 5 years or has taken the Accuplacer Test
- Completion of year 1 LPN prerequisites classes. Must have above 3.0 GPA (80% or above).
- Maintain a current Certified Nurse Aid (CNA) license.

HOW TO APPLY

- Submit application form and supporting documents (found on the SGU Nursing Website) by March 15, 2024.
- Official High school and College transcripts submitted to Registrar office by March 1, 2024.
- Once the above has been met and approved, contact Marissa Bordeaux (605)856-8284 to arrange an appointment to take the preadmission exam: TEAS. You will be required to check out a TEAS exam study manual and receive a tutoring session prior to testing. Student must achieve a TEAS exam score of 60% or higher.
- You will receive a notification letter indicating whether you've been accepted into the program or not.
